


## State of California Proposition 65

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 also referred to as "Prop 65" was designed to warn consumers in the State of California that "products may contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm".

There are now over 900 chemicals on the Prop 65. The list contains a wide range of chemicals found in everyday items, including dyes, solvents, pesticides, drugs, food additives and byproducts of certain manufacturing processes.

Metpar products may have trace quantities of these various chemicals (nickel, chromium, lead, arsenic, cadmium, and formaldehyde) as a result of the typical manufacturing processes used in producing galvanized steel, stainless steel or various forms of plastic products. These chemicals are merely present and do not represent "any significant risk" from exposure or use. These trace elements do not present an inhalation, ingestion or skin hazard.

As Metpar sells its products around the globe and therefore it is difficult to ascertain which products were ultimately delivered to and installed in California locations. As a result, Metpar has decided to post this warning for all our products, regardless of ultimate destination.
